As a class, read I Thessalonians 4:13-18.

One of the reasons the subject of the rapture is controversial is that the word **rapture**, like the word _____, _____ in the Bible. But then, as we have pointed out before, the word _____ in the Bible.

We actually get the word **rapture** from the Greek word **harpazo**, which means "to carry off, grasp hastily; snatch up; to seize and overpower." From this we get our word **rapture**.
