



Revival Through Pentecostal Power

[1] And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

[2] And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

[3] And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

[4] And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:1-4

Let us also read verses 12-21.

The day of Pentecost was the springboard of a great revival. Let's look at what can happen when real revival comes. When real hungering and thirsting causes us to earnestly seek God for His divine power.

Let's look at eight things that came with real revival.

1. There was a spiritual awakening among the disciples.
2. There was a spiritual awareness in the community.
3. There was a mighty empowering in the church.
4. There was a powerful attraction to the crowd.
5. There was a majestic preaching by the disciples.
6. There was great conviction for sin.
7. There were dynamic conversions.
8. There were outstanding miracles.

We need to **regain** Pentecost to recapture the world. We need a revival by which our nation becomes **spiritually awakened** and **morally transformed**.

Let's look at some different definitions of revival.

"The church falling in love with Jesus." (Vance Havner)

"Revival is a community saturated with God." (Duncan Campbell)

"Revival means days of heaven upon the earth." (D. Martyn Lloyd-Jones)

*"Revival is God revealing Himself to man in **awful holiness** and **irresistible power**..." (Arthur Wallis)*

And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.

Let's look at things the Holy Spirit accomplished at Pentecost, and what He can do in every true revival.

1. Christ was exalted. As He was lifted up, thousands were drawn to Him.
2. There was increased Christ-likeness among the people of God. There was repentance that resulted in the cleansing of hearts and lives.
3. There was discipline of the erring that brought a reverence, both by the Christians and toward the Christians.
4. There was increased knowledge of the truth. They continued in the **Apostles Doctrine**, line upon line, and precept upon precept.
5. The church was stirred and energized to labor towards the ends of the world, engaging in Global Missions.

And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
