



## Revival Through Pentecostal Products

Acts 2:42-47

Pentecostal preaching resulted in Pentecostal Products. These products were believers who were glorious in life and ministry. Remember, these converts were people who came to Christ through the preaching of believers who had tarried in the upper room in obedience to the words of Jesus Christ.

*And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.* **Luke 24:49**

*And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.* **Acts 1:4**

The people preaching had received the promised power and preached with that power. The Pentecostal Products we are speaking of were both those who had tarried until filled, and those who came to Christ through their preaching.

How can we produce Pentecostal Believers as of old?

Let's look at the situation as it is so often today. Converts refuse to become disciples. Disciples refuse to become leaders. Leaders refuse to catch the vision. Because of these conditions revival does not continue. We must pray that God will reverse this situation.

LET'S LOOK AT SOME NOTABLE FEATURES IN THESE PENTECOSTAL PRODUCTS.

1. Their hearts were touched by the claims of the Gospel of Christ. Acts 2:37
2. They gladly received the Word of God. Acts 2:41 Surely the condition of the preachers had a great effect.
3. They were promptly baptized. There was no reluctance or vacillation. The Holy Spirit instructed their hearts that obedience to the Lord of the Harvest was a must. Acts 2:41
4. They were added to the Lord and the saints (Church). The Lord was not ashamed to include them in His group. They had chosen the way of holiness. Acts 2:42
5. They continued steadfastly in the Apostles' doctrine. They were eager to mature, to become like their teachers. Acts 2:42
6. They continued in fellowship. They loved the fellowship of Christ and the saints. Acts 2:42

7. They continued in the breaking of bread. To them, whatever Christ commanded was law. Acts 2:42
8. They continued in prayers. Acts 2:42; 1 Timothy 2:1-4
9. God, in awful and awesome power, moved through these holy congregations effecting great miracles through His apostles. Acts 2:43
10. They had all things common. The happenings were great and wonderful. People were not in a hurry to leave Jerusalem. They sold their goods and freely gave to the needy. Acts 2:44, 45
11. They continued these holy practices with joy and gladness, and people were being saved daily. Acts 2:46, 47
12. They were slow in carrying out the great commission, given in Matthew 28:19, 20; Mark 16:15, and Acts 1:8 until persecution came. Acts 8:1-4
